On October 3, 2013, the United Farm Workers of America filed the enclosed Notice of Intent to Take Access in the Oxnard office of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board, in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 20900 (the "Access Regulations"), available at http://www.alrb.ca.gov/content/statutesregulations/regulations/regulations_default.html.

This document, now having been filed and docketed by our Agency, entitles organizers of the filing labor organization to enter the property of the employer to meet and talk with employees for one hour before work, one hour after work, and one hour during lunch, subject to the limitations and guidelines set forth in the Access Regulations.

As part of our initial investigation of the Notice of Intent to Take Access, we request your cooperation by providing our office with the following information by October 10, 2013: 1) the number of agricultural employees currently employed by [REDACTED] Farms, including employees hired through farm labor contractors, 2) a list of the principal crops grown by [REDACTED] Farms, and 3) a list of the work sites and corresponding addresses of all [REDACTED] Farms agricultural employees, including those hired through farm labor contractors.

Today I called you and was transferred to your employee, [REDACTED]. I explained the Access Regulations to her, and requested she advise you that we are available to answer any questions you may have. Please feel free to contact the ALRB office at any time.
